Another thing we asked is "how do you feel about high school?" "I'm nervous and excited" was Izzy's answer.

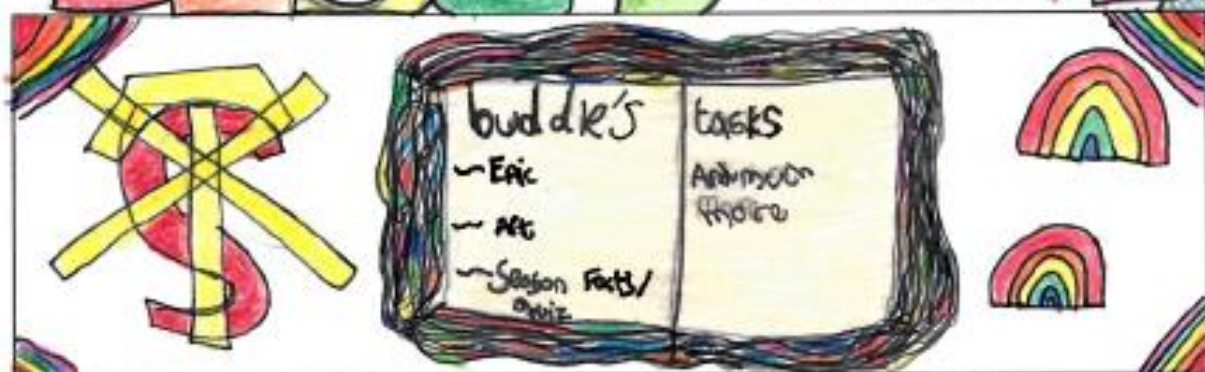
We asked "how does it feel being the eldest in the school?" "weird" Kyle said, "Breat" said Helena.

The first question we asked was who was your favorite activity we've done with you? They said "Drawing". Next we asked, what is your favorite thing about buddies? They replied...

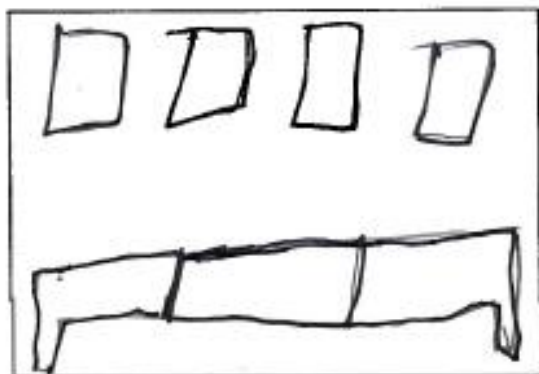
"To spend time with buddies!" After that we asked, "What's your favorite thing about your classroom?" They said "Always drawing and the toys to play with!"

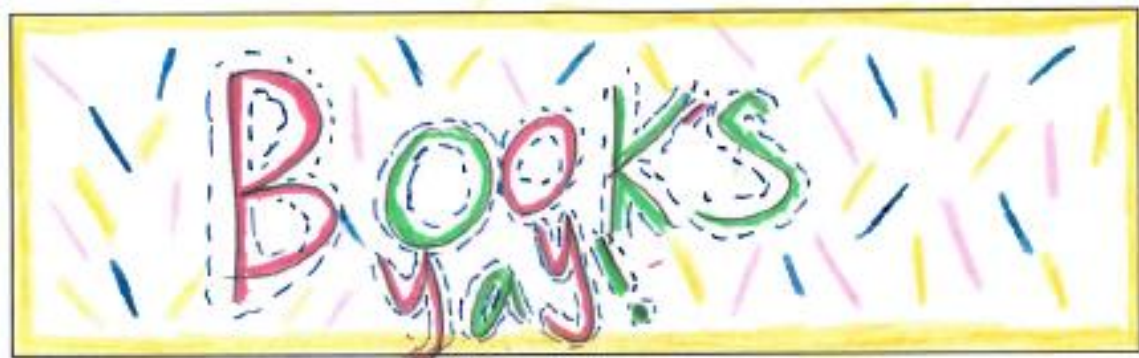

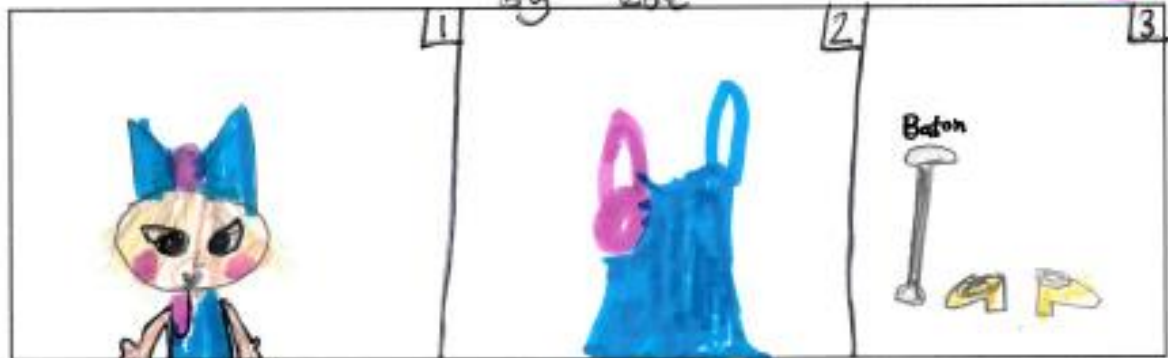

ON the Friday the 10th of February P5 and P4/5 ran a whole school book drive! And

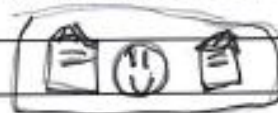
Selling books for free and we managed to sell around 424

Thanks a lot for coming to the book fair!

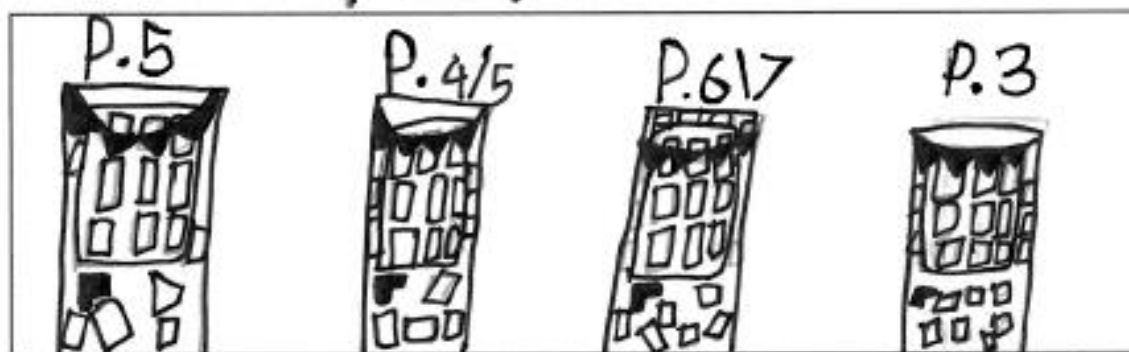




# Tollcross Door Competition

## Let the Best Door Win

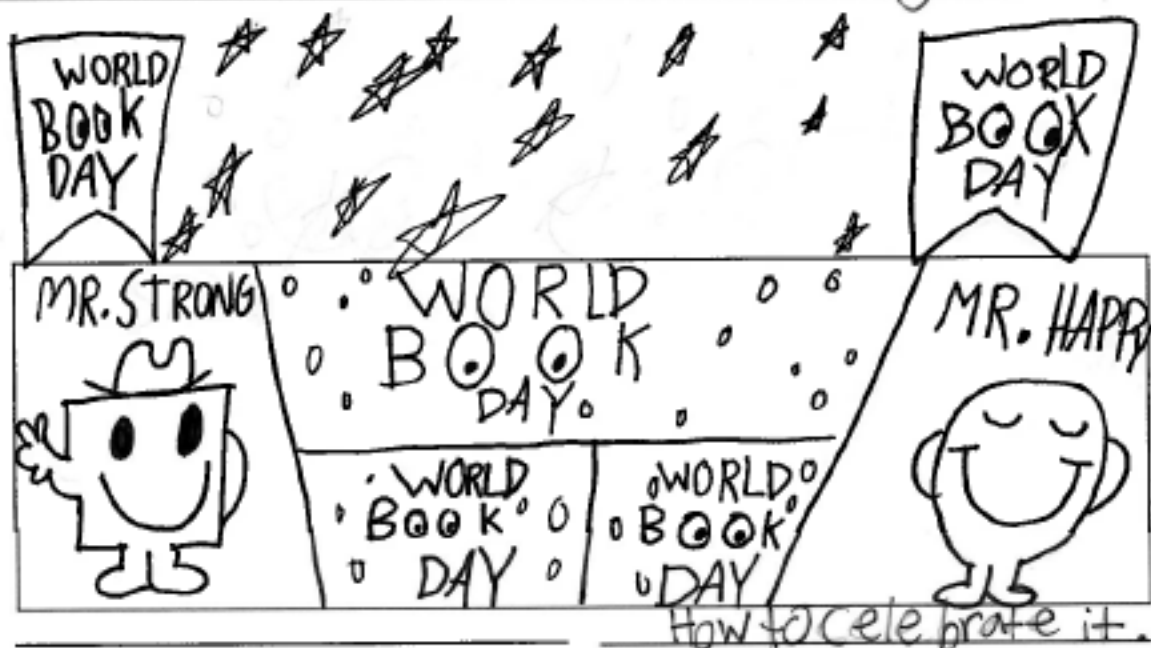
